2. Choose 3 of your 5 books to complete the enclosed projects on. Turn this packet in on the first day of school.
3. This completed packet will count as your first reading grade. If your books are AR books, you may take these tests to count as points for the parties and rewards, but they will not count as points for your 25 AR points that are due each nine weeks for a grade in reading.
4. Please do not read the following books:
The Magician's Nephew, The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, Ghost Cadet, Tuck Everlasting, The Bridge to Terebithia, Blood on the River, or The Runaway King series

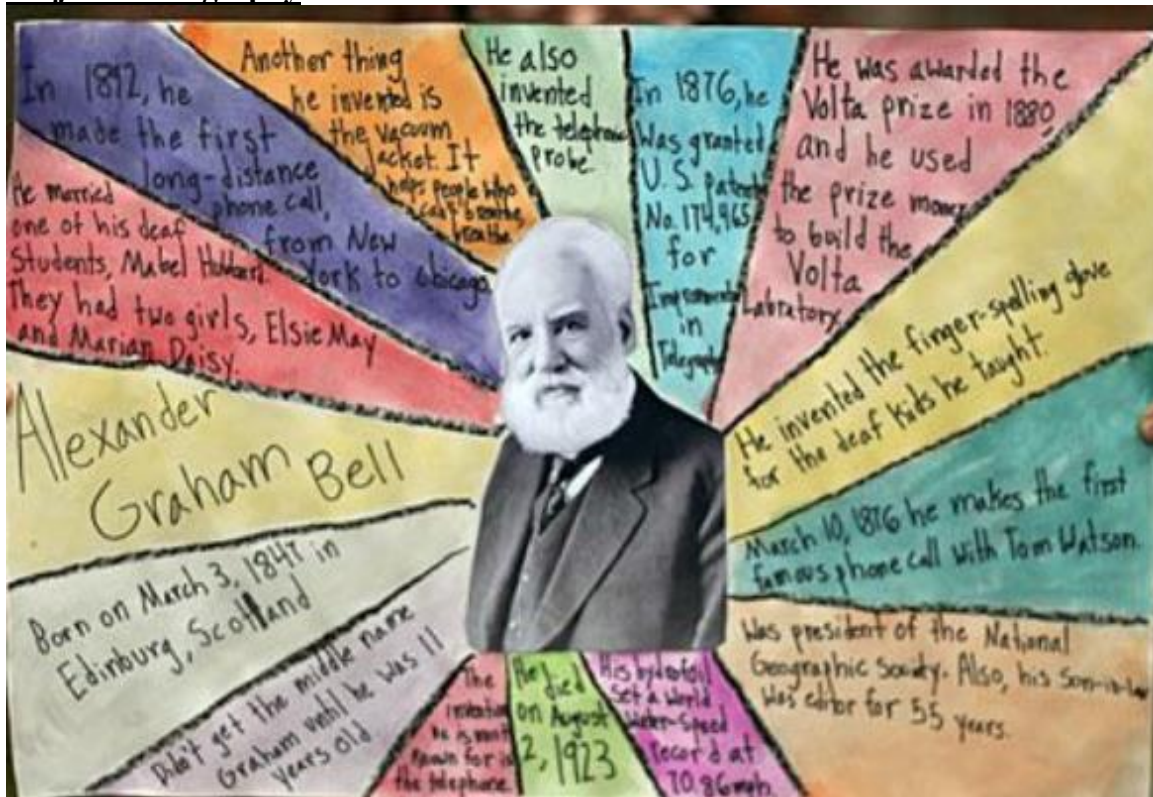
